

MYS Mask & Spectator COVID-19 Protocols

MYS has updated the club's mask and spectator policies for practices, games, and events. The following policy will be effective on **February 18, 2022** and will remain in effect until further notice:

- Coaches, players, spectators, referees, and club officials, who are not fully vaccinated should wear a mask when in crowded areas while at MYS facilities. This may include walking to and from the field or standing on the sidelines.
- Players have the OPTION of wearing a mask while participating in active training or competition regardless of vaccine status.
- Anyone in the quarantine/isolation protocol must wear a mask at all times regardless of vaccine status:
 - Players will have to train/play games with a mask from Day 5-10 according to the CDC guidelines.
 - OR -
 - Remain quarantined/isolated and not attend training/games.
- Spectators should continue to social distance when possible.
- Spectators are permitted to accompany their player to and from the fields but please do not congregate around entrances and exits.
- Spectators should come to the field no sooner than 5 minutes prior to kickoff.
- MYS families must abide by any and all rules in place at non-MYS venues.

MYS continues to focus on keeping our players and community safe. We will continue to monitor the situation and keep you updated of any changes.
